ARRIVAL INFORMATION

On arrival you pass the small village shop, $\frac{1}{4}$ mile up the hill just as you see the sea views, there is a right hand turn in to Carreglwyd Estate, head over two cattle grids, after the second turn LEFT following signs for campsite. Stay on the track through the two large fields, you will see the toilets. This is the main camping field although both are open. Please do not drive into the main estate as weddings maybe taking place.

Waste- Recycling bins are located at the exit



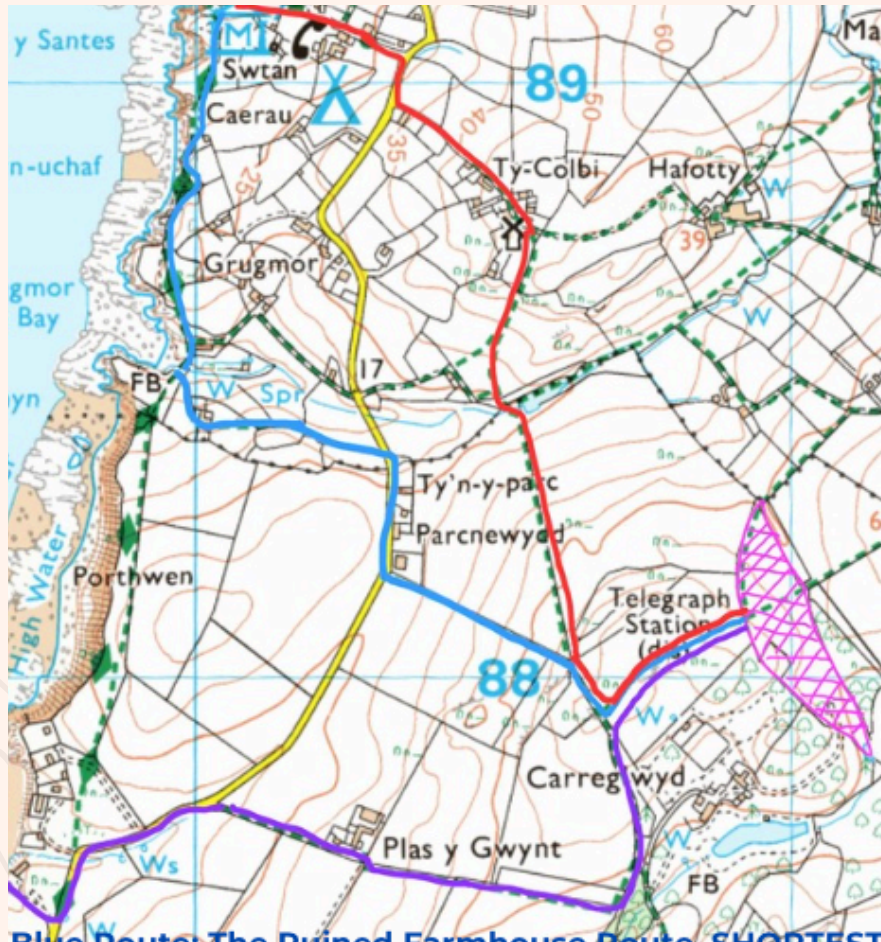
BEACH ACCESS

BEACH ACCESS ROUTES



- From the signal tower, walk through the gate that you entered the field from, and turn right to follow the stone track up and over the hill.
- There are two gates to two different fields in front of you: take the right hand gate and walk down the hedge to the bottom corner of the field where you will find a small pond and a bridge over a little stream.
- On the other side of the stream you need to take the steps up the bank to a stile and over into a field. Walk through the middle of this field towards the old windmill, passing through a gate and into a smaller field as you go.
- At the windmill, walk down the road to the bottom, turn right onto the larger road, and take the first left down to Church Bay

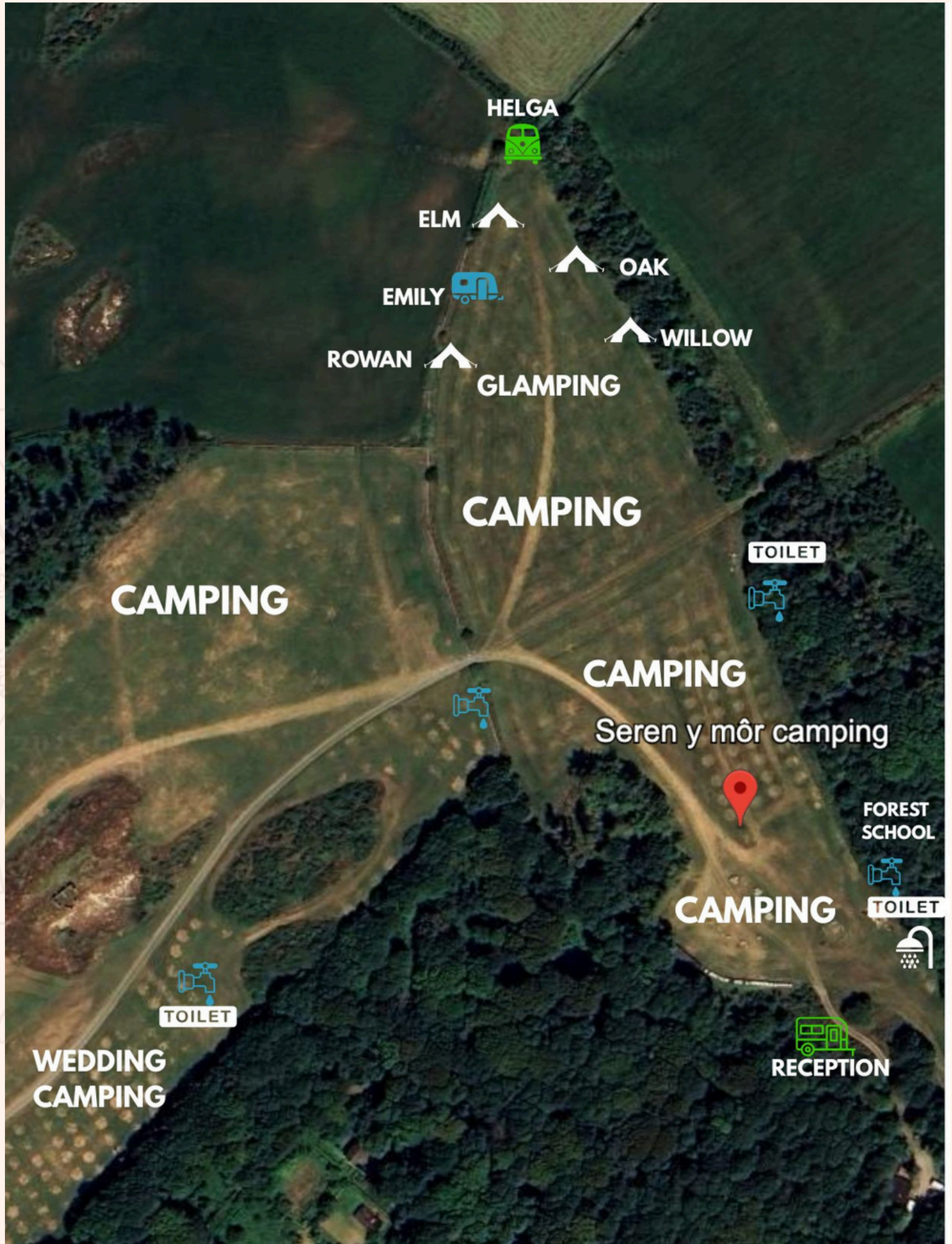
Blue Route: The Ruined Farmhouse Route. SHORTEST ROUTE TO THE SEA.

- From the signal tower, walk through the gate that you entered the field from, and turn right to follow the stone track up and over the hill.
- There are two gates at the end of this track, and to the left of them is a stone stile. Go over the stile and walk down the right hand side of the field to a stile in the bottom corner.
- Go over the stile onto the road and turn right. You can follow this road all the way to the left turn signposted down to Church Bay.
- If you would rather take the coastal path, in all of its stunning glory, then turn right and walk 200m from the stile until you see a footpath sign leading into a field on your left.
- Follow the track, keeping the hedge on your left, through three small fields, and then walk through the middle of the fourth field towards the ruins of an old farmhouse.
- Pass through the ruins and immediately turn right and follow the hedge down to a small beach, Porth Grugmor.
- Grugmor is a lovely place to spend some time, and the coastal path leading north is truly spectacular, with a number of beautifully secluded coves along the way to Church Bay.

Purple Route: The House of the Wind route

- From the signal tower, walk through the gate that you entered the field from, and turn left to follow the stone track down the hill.
- At the bottom of the hill, instead of joining the driveway of the estate, look up at the gateway into the field where you will see a kissing gate. Go through this gate, keep to the left, and walk towards the tree line, where you will see a gate in the corner of the field.
- Through this gate there is a path that leads to a stile over into a field. Turn right in the field and follow the trees up and over the hill. Walk down the hill with the hedge on your right, walking towards a farm. You'll pass through into another field halfway down the hill.
- When possible, walk through the gates to the farm, this is Plas y Gwynt, the house of the wind, and turn left down the driveway to the road.
- Turn left onto the road and follow until you see a small car park, an orange life ring, and an information board. This is Porth Trwyn, also known as Borthwen beach.

Chemist:

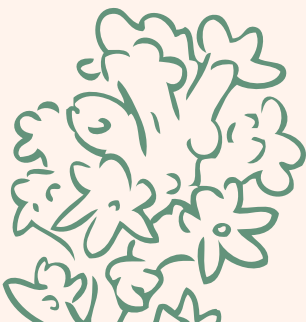
The nearest chemist can be found in Holyhead.

Proud to be an Eco site

Our hot showers and compost toilets are constructed using simple and upcycled materials, and what would be waste from a normal toilet is turned into a resource for returning nutrients to an area of woodland that we have set aside for coppicing, meaning that what you leave behind is turned into trees and woodland soils.

Our water on site comes from our borehole, and goes through UV filtration before being pumped to the taps and showers. It is fresh tasting and has been filtered by the rock beneath your feet.

All taps on the campsite are drinking water

We ask that you consider what you bring with you to our rustic site, as we are regularly shocked with the amount of single use camping gear these days. With that said, there will be a recycling point on site, with separate bins to ensure that none of the waste produced on site goes to landfill.

Please remember **LOVE THIS PLACE- LEAVE NO TRACE**, take everything you brought back home with you to reuse.

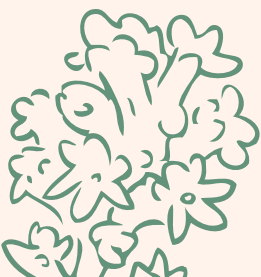

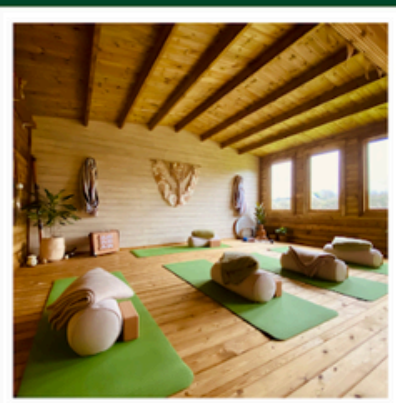
